New Certification



 In an effort to standardize PPE program, the PPE Advisory Committee upgraded the PPE certification Process

- Two Certificates
 - Certificate of Training Completion
 - PPE Certificate



Training Certificate

- Training Completion
 - Reflects that student has undergone a PPE training and is now knowledgeable on PPE Curriculum
 - Infant Mortality
 - Preconception Health
 - Social Determinants of Health
 - Life Course Perspective
 - Fatherhood
 - STIs





PPE Certificate

- After the student completes a set number of activities the student will be recognized as a PPE
- Affiliation to a campus, organization, etc.
- 1 recruitment event per semester
- 1 training per school year
- 2 Campus activities per semester
- Must attend 6/8 Webinars per school year.





Reporting



- Training Certificate
 - Excel Sheet with contact information for all newly trained students
- PPE Certificate
 - New PPE reporting form
 - Must be approved by faculty adviser
