Services include:

- Young women's health
- Reproductive health

- Routine counseling, including mental health services
- Tobacco cessation
- Substance abuse screening and referrals as needed

When students feel better, they:

- Do better in school and have higher graduation rates.
- Are involved in fewer school discipline cases.
- Live healthier lives, with the information they need on nutrition, physical activity, and health education.



Confidentiality is ensured by keeping school and medical records separate.



Written parental permission is necessary for services to be provided.



Services are available whether the child's family or caregiver has the ability to pay or not.
