




RACE/ETHNICITY DISPARITIES

According to the 2020/2021 National Survey of Children's Health, 28.2% of Delaware adolescents, ages 12 through 17, did not obtain a preventive medical visit last year.


This is slightly lower compared to the national average of 30.4% of adolescents who did not obtain a preventive medical visit.

Develop a cross-system partnership and protocols to increase the proportion of adolescents receiving annual preventive services.


Increase the number of adolescents, ages 12 through 17, with a preventive medical visit in the past year.
